Mud Pies Grove is a **magical space** where children can **explore** their **senses** and connect with nature through different open activities. One of our nature educators transforms the space, tells **stories**, plays ukulele and sings **songs**, encouraging children and parents to try new things over a two hour session.

Mud Pies Grove is available for playgroups, child care centres, schools, birthday parties and festivals.

Cost is **\$250** +GST per 2 hour session with 1 facilitator for up to 30 children or **\$500** +GST per 2 hour session with 2 facilitators for up to 60 children.

Music and Adventure

With ukuleles, shakers and ribbons we celebrate nature together with old and new nursery rhymes and songs.

Storytelling Hut

Underneath a cubby of sticks and fabric, a pile of picture books is waiting to be read in a quiet and peaceful space.



Clay Play

Sticky, soft and hard clay with water and natural materials invite children to take a sensory risk, get messy, and make mud pies and nature sculptures. Beaches are sandy, play dough is clean but clay sticks, slides, soothes and dries.



Whittling and Sanding

Children love sticks! Through the use of safe whittling equipment and sand paper, children can transform their found stick into a treasured, smooth sword... wand... whatever their imagination creates! Children reveal what is beneath the bark and discover what they can achieve through the use of tools.



Nature Crowns

Dressing up is always fun especially when you get to dress with nature. Children collect fascinating natural materials to design and create a nature headband and/or cuff and become imaginary characters in outdoor play.
